1535 - 1545	Scottish Memorial, Frezenberg Ridge, Zonnebeke
1605 - 1635	Tyne Cot Cemetery and Visitor Centre  Largest cemetery of Commonwealth soldiers' graves of any war, anywhere in the world.
1700 - 1715	Welsh Memorial, Boezingestraat 115, Langemark
1720 - 1735	Artillery Wood Cemetery, Poezelstratat Boezinge, West-Vlaanderen Graves of Irish poet, Francis Ledwidge (Lce Cpl F.E Ledgwidge) and Welsh poet Hedd Wyn (Pte E. H. Evans)
1800 - 1900	Early dinner at VIVALDI Restaurant, Hosted by the Embassies of United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland, Belgium Grote Markt 19-21, Ypres (centre)
